1. Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Raymond Concho, Jr., provided the attached report to the Commission (report attached). Discussion began on the following items:

- ❖ Administration Jonathan McKinney, a Dartmouth College student intern will be volunteering services on December 15-31, 1999 and February 7 March 21, 2000. He will be helping to prepare PAHA's newsletter and public relations.
- ❖ The FY 1998 Audit is ongoing. A report will be available in Spring 2000. PAHA will be able to respond with corrections. Gordon Stasiak of HDS is to meet with the auditors at 9 AM tomorrow on the payment collection system. It was reported that only five (5) findings were reported by the auditors. This demonstrates that we have a sound housing authority in place. Vice Chairman Chavez requested a year end update on TAR balances beginning with the initial amount and comparing the reductions to date.
- A goal of a \$200,000 in the reduction in TARs will be made by March 2001. The Collection & Evictions Policies are in place and have been used to begin the process of collecting on TARs. Court hearings on the Notice of Termination & Evictions will begin in January 2000.
- A copy of PAHA's Annual Performance Report (APR) has been shared with the Tribal Administration, Council and BOC.
- The status of Project Number NM79-07 is still in arbitration. One (1) is bindering the closure of this project as well as the issue of Indirect Cost Services (IDC).
- Mr. Concho reported that the Reauthorization of NAHASDA & Block Grants and their funding formulas will be re-evaluated.
- ♦ HOC I & II to be attending a Mortgage training in San Antonio, TX from January 9-13, 2000. Their job descriptions will be remodified to include mortgaging activities.
- The Tribal Attorney, Ann Rogers had some questions/concerns on the Mortgage Code, she will provide those concerns in writing to the Tribal Secretary for include if any as amendments to the approved Mortgage Code.
- NAIHC Board of Director's quarterly meeting is January 10-11, 2000 in Phoenix, AZ; SWIHA A quarterly meeting is January 11-14, 2000 in Scottsdale, AZ; the Amerind Risk Management Corporation Board of Directors quarterly meetings are scheduled for January 16-20, 2000 in Honolulu, Hawaii. Executive Director is requesting travel approval to attend the meetings mentioned above.

Motion to accept the Executive Director's report was made by Vice Chairman Chavez, seconded by Commissioner Chino, motion carries.

2. Tribal Council Report

Chairman Harold Felipe reported that on November 23, 1999 the Acoma Tribal Council approved the Mortgage Code. Chairman Felipe commended the PAHA staff and the BOC for their input into the Mortgage Code's development and approval. Mr. Concho was key in convincing the Tribal Council of the importance of the Mortgage Code in helping to address the needs of the Acoma

people. Chairman Felipe recommended that the PAHA staff provide training and/or reiterate information on PAHA issues and the Mortgage Code to the Tribal Council and any new councilmen at the beginning of the year.

- 1. HUD letter requesting tribal representation to draft proposed "Tribal Consultation Policy"

 Mr. Concho presented the letter to the BOC from HUD requesting tribal representation to participate in a work group that will draft a tribal consultation policy discussion paper. Tribal comments and recommendations will be the basis for drafting the new consultation policy. The preliminary draft policy discussion paper will incorporate recommendations received from tribal leaders in the regional meetings and will note alternatives for consultation procedures raised by tribes. The BOC accepted Mr. Concho's recommendation to allow Ms. Denise Chee to represent the Pueblo of Acoma.
- 2. Training: Draft Mortgage Land Lease Agreement by Denise Chee Legal Attorney, Denise Chee provided the BOC with a quick, but brief interpretation of the residential/land lease agreement. The BOC requested additional training on the agreement at another time with Ms. Chee.
